COMPANIONWAYS

Strongly constructed steel companionways readily opened from both sides fitted at the corners of the Shelter Deck Hatchways - Two (2) on Nos. 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6 hatchways - One (1) on No. 3. These companionways welded to hatch coaming and hatch beam adjacent to coaming. Efficient arrangements made to batten tarpaulins in way of companionways.

SANITARY DISCHARGES

Additional sanitary discharges fitted from Hospital in No. 1 Upper Tween Deck and Washplace in No. 6 Upper Tween Deck. These discharge overboard below the second deck, one cast steel clapper valve fitted at each outlet.
