With reference to the case of the "CRESTVILLE" concerning which you last wrote on the 27th July, 1962, the Owners have decided to scrap the ship.

In the circumstances, our Surveyor went on board to deal with the machinery qualification of class and agreed that he could recommend an extension of the limit to cover the voyage to the breakers Yard.

The vessel sailed on the 28th August, for Preston and has arrived at the Yard of T.W. Ward Ltd., where she will now be broken up.
