A. Your letter of the 25th instant addressed to Mr. A. E. Farminer, the Society's Surveyor at Ipswich, regarding the certificates for three sets of Concrete Tug Engines made by Messrs. Davey, Paxman & Co., to the order of the Ministry of Shipping, has been forwarded to this Office, and with reference thereto I may say that no previous communication appears to have been received from your London Office on the subject.

I may say, however, that no certificates have been issued in respect of the Engines in question, and in the ordinary way classification certificates cannot be issued until these Engines have been satisfactorily fitted on board a vessel classed with this Society.

To meet your wishes, however, special certificates have been drawn up by the Society's Surveyor under whose inspection these Engines were constructed at the Makers' works, and I have pleasure in handing you the same herewith, and trust they will meet your requirements.
