Dear Sirs,

F. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the "ALEXANDRA", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the moulded draught corresponding to the summer freeboard which could be assigned with the present scantlings of the vessel is 17'6", representing an increase of $3\frac{1}{4}$ " over the present moulded draught.

No modification in the present closing appliances of the poop bulkhead will be necessary for this increase in draught.

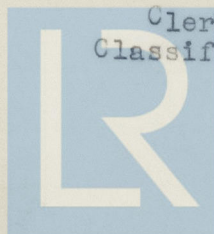
As the present freeboards were assigned by the Danish Authorities, I shall be glad if you will advise the Authorities as above, and in the event of a re-assignment being made, you should forward the usual verification of marking form in order that the records in the Register Book may be amended.
