Confirming telephone conversation of recent date we would be grateful if you would please submit on our behalf this application to the Committee for dispensation to enable us to continue trading with this vessel until the 31st May, 1964.

The vessel concerned is currently engaged on bunkering duties in the London River and it would be our intention to continue with this work and confine the vessel to 'River and Estorial' limites only. The current demand for this vessel's services is such that we are having great difficulty in terminating her activities for the purpose of carrying out the Special Survey, now due.

It will be our intention, should the Committee agree to our request, to eventually substitute this vessel with 'Aureity' whose present Charter will terminate in May of this year, when Survey can then be held on 'Allurity'.

This submission is, of course, contingent on your requirements in the matter of Surveys for the purpose of the requested extension.
