Herewith I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant relative my First Entry Report No. 18282 on the s.s. "WANDLE". In reply I may state that the breaking tests to which the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ",  $2\frac{1}{4}$ ", and  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " steel wires have been submitted are 21.7 tons, 10.8 tons and 6.4 tons. The thickness of the bridge deck plating is as approved namely .26.
