In reply to your memorandum of the 10th February, I have to say that the Committee are agreeable to a General Examination of the hull and machinery being held in drydock about May next, as proposed, with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey until not later than the end of March 1965.

The Continuous Survey of the machinery is considerably behindhand and should be advanced at the drydocking when, it is concluded, the Screwshaft Survey, due at the end of June next, will be held.


