CLASSING LETTER

512/ 524 "AL SAYYADA". As recommended, except that the machinery class has not been continued subject to the mooring winch starboard side shaft being renewed by the end of this month, in view of the fact that this is not a classification item.

In the circumstances, an amended Interim Certificate should be issued omitting reference to this item.

520 "SAFINA-E-JAMHOORIYAT". As recommended, except that a notation of MBS 5.63 has now been assigned.

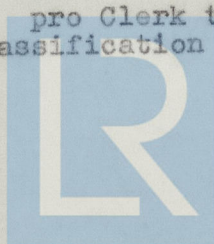
In this connection I have to inform you that a letter has been received from the Owners stating that they intend to operate on saturated steam only, thus eliminating the superheater elements completely.

As there is no objection to this, I shall be glad if you will issue an amended Interim Certificate recommending a fresh record of MBS 5.63 now, (as previously recommended) without any mention of the superheater elements etc.
