on 18th to 24th March, 1954 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~found~~:-


ALTERATIONS:-

24" x 63" coaming 18" secured by steel dogs
Poop front teak doors replaced by steel watertight doors, manipulated from both sides.

Hold access hatches, within mast houses, coamings increased to 24" by welded steel plates.

Dining Saloon windows, steel cover plate fastenings re-inforced.

Gyro Room (at forward starboard end of midship deck house) portlight fitted with outside steel portable cover.
