("In relation to technical characteristics")

This is to Certify that at the request of

the Owner's Agents and with the consent of the Master, the undersigned Surveyor to this Society attended on board the S.S. "GALAXIAS", 5449 gross tons of PINAEUS on the 15th March, 1967, and subsequently, whilst afloat in Visakhapatnam Harbour for the purpose of ascertaining fitness of ship to be towed as a hulk.

I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all temporary repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction and also that I am recommending that she is, so far as structural efficiency is concerned, fit to be towed, with Classification suspended, to a Japanese Port. The extent of marine growth on the ship's bottom could, however, render towage impracticable.

NOTE:- Towing arrangements are the responsibility of the Owners.
