This is to Certify that according to the records in this Office this ship sustained damage stated to be a result of grounding on the 25th May, 1966.

The Society's Surveyors attended on board at Visakhapatnam on the 29th May and subsequently but no action was taken in regard to classification pending a decision being made concerning repairs.

On the 27th June, 1966 information was received from the Society's Surveyors at Visakhapatnam to the effect that following a fire, stated to have taken place on the 24th June, a preliminary examination showed that the machinery had been badly damaged.

The case received the consideration of the Committee on the 5th August, 1966 when the notation "Repairs required - Class Suspended 8.66" was assigned.
