This is to Certify *that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the S.S. 'APJ AMBAR' 5449 gross tons of Calcutta for survey of damage and wear and tear repairs as she lay afloat and at anchor at this port on 12th January 1966 and subsequently and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained ~~and the following survey records assigned~~ without fresh record of survey but subject to:*

- i) the new eccentric rod now placed on board being suitably machined and fitted on the main circulating water pump
 - ii) the valve spindle crosshead bush being renewed
- Parts now examined:— cooding, and to any other conditions as previously recommended.

Parts now examined for damage: Main condenser circulating water pump.

Parts now examined for wear and tear: Port Feed Water Pump
