and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be retained as classed without fresh record of dry docking but subject to the No.4 hold being specially examined for fire damage in Bombay or Calcutta where stated proceeding after unloading at Sikka but not later than 31st December, 1965, and to all conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.


