Dear Sir,

S.S. "INDIAN ENDEAVOUR"

With reference to your letter of the 11th July, we have to advise you that the Committee's instructions were conveyed to the owners and we give below the contents from their reply, which will be self explanatory.

"We thank you for your letter Ref.I/940 dated 19th July, 1966, from which we are pleased to note that your Principals have advised you that they are agreeable to a General Examination of the hull and machinery of this vessel including the testing of the bilge suction being carried out at Calcutta.

"We note, however, that in view of the age of the vessel, the Committee consider that the General Examination should be held by the end of the present month, which is the due date for Special Survey. In this connection, we have to advise you that the vessel has already sailed from the Indian Coast prior to the receipt of your letter and is on her present voyage to the Persian Gulf. She is scheduled to complete discharge in the Persian Gulf about 15th August, 1966, and then return to Calcutta by about the end of August when we shall arrange for the vessel to be at the disposal of your Surveyors for the General Examination."
