AUNG TEZA. — Rangoon, June 9. — Reports reaching Rangoon say that 55 passengers are feared to have drowned when the Government-operated motor vessel Aung Teza capsized in heavy seas 80 miles south of Maulmain late on Wednesday night (June 7). The report added that only 25 passengers and crew managed to reach the shore 12 miles from where the vessel sank. The Aung Teza left Rangoon (for Singapore) with 400 tons of rice and 80 passengers and crew. She sank near the mouth of the River Ye. — British United Press.

AUNG TEZA. — Maulmain, June 10. — Motor vessel Aung Teza sank south-west of Kalegawk Island at 6 50 p.m., June 7. (See issue of June 10.)

Rangoon, June 10. — Motor vessel Aung Teza, with 130 passengers and 400 tons of rice on board, reported foundered on June 7 near Kalegawk Island, south of Maulmain.

Rangoon, June 10. — Sixty-seven people are feared to have drowned in motor vessel Aung Teza, which sank off the Tenasserim coast with 124 people on board, according to Press reports here to-day. The vessel was reported to have gone down in a gale on Wednesday night (June 7). Two coastal schooners picked up 57 survivors and took them to Maulmain. — Reuter.

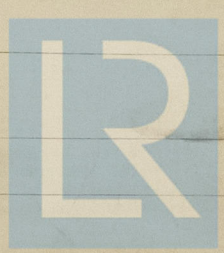
