Dear Sirs, of this letter is being sent to the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg.

## Steamer "STANLAND"

The case of the above named ship has been under consideration today in connection with your letter of the 4th instant.

In reply I regret to inform you that for the following reasons the Committee do not see their way further to advance the date of the Special Survey assigned in this instance.

You will recall that the Special Survey was actually held in October, 1957, after which the ship was laid up; and, in accordance with your request in June, 1960, a General Examination was held with a view to the date being amended to SS 6.60 (Adv.). This means that the next Special Survey will not fall due until June, 1964, by which time the double bottom tanks will not have been seen for nearly seven years and, if your present request were granted, they would not be seen for about eight years. This would be quite contrary to the spirit of the Society's Rules and the Committee, therefore, consider they would not be justified in granting any further concession in this instance.

I would add, however, that should you so desire the Committee would be prepared to advance the date of the Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys from 6.60 to 5.61, if you arrange for the boilers to be again generally examined internally and externally to ensure that no

The ship will then be 24 years of age and in the circumstances it is considered that no further advancement of the Special Survey date should be granted.
