A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) due 7,57 was carried out at Hamburg and Notation of 'SS 10,57' assigned for which the ship was laid up.

At the request of the Owners the ship was examined at Hamburg 6,60 for advancement of the Special Survey notation which was assigned 'SS 6,60(Adv.)'.

The Owners now request in letter dated 5.6.1 a further advancement of the Special Survey date.

If this further request is agreed to a notation 'SS 6,61(Adv.)' would be assigned which would mean that the next Special Survey would become due in 6,65 with a possibility of a year of grace, making a period of about 9 years without a full Special Survey being held.

The ship will then be 24 years of age and in these circumstances it is considered that no further advancement of the Special Survey date should be granted.


