This ship was under survey at Hamburg in May/June when an examination was carried out in drydock after the lay up period, with a view to advancement of the Special Survey dates.


As a result of the satisfactory nature of this inspection, the Committee have agreed to up-to-date notations being assigned in respect of the Special Survey of the hull and the Engine Survey. Accordingly notations of Special Survey 6.60 (Adv.) and Engine Survey 6.60 (Adv.) have been assigned, together with records of Docking Survey 5.60, Screwshaft Renewal 5.60, and Main Boiler Survey 6.60. The Official Classification Certificates in respect of the Special Survey and Engine Survey are enclosed.

I take this opportunity to inform you that the ship's class is at present subject to indented side shell plating etc., in way of No. 1 hold (port side) and indented and set in shell plates F.7, G.7, 8 and 14, H. 8, 9 and 14, J. 8 (port side) F. 12 and 13, G. 11, H. 11, J. 15, and 16 (starboard side) all from forward being repaired at the next drydocking.
