Vessel is now expected to slip in the course of a week or so, when it is hoped an opportunity will be afforded to get particulars & carry out a Confirmatory Survey.

Fee has not yet been rendered, as it was thought this should be rendered after survey was completed, in case any extra fee was considered advisable.
