Air and Sounding pipes were examined and found satisfactory,  
the Sounding pipes have a welded doubler on the Shell  
underneath.  
Seacocks and Valves were all examined and found in good  
condition in January, 1949.  
Holding down bolts all tested and found in good condition.  
All electrical circuits were Megger tested and found  
to be satisfactory.

As regards the Class for this vessel. I am informed  
Mr. Channer that Lieut. Col. The Hon. Eyres Mauncell applied  
for Cross Channel and Coasting Service (British) and that if  
there is any misunderstanding on this point, that is what is  
required.
