On the 21st January, 1958, the Caracas Surveyor stated that the tanker was to be taken out of service and the Committee agreed to the outstanding Surveys remaining in abeyance meantime provided they be dealt with before the tanker again proceeds to sea.

The Caracas Surveyor now cables that the tanker has been sold to Simmons Staalhandel, Rotterdam (a firm of Shipbreakers) and has sailed under her own power to Curacao without survey at Caracas. The Curacao Surveyor in a letter dated 19th January, 1959 states that the ship is now laid up at Curacao and has been renamed "WAALHAVEN" with port or registry Curacao.
