With I beg to inform you, that I was requested by the Petroleum Corporation to pay a visit to their Office where I learnt, that the idea is that the "Esso Pedernales" and "Esso Maracay", will be laid up in the Lake of La Salina and that the "Creole" wants the following 'Laid up-surveys overdue-class suspended 2/58.

The signal letters of the "Esso Pedernales" appears to be Z.

Due to being out of the station for quite a time I became late in sending the reports of the following surveys, which I am enclosing now:

- "Miranda" - Special Survey.
- "Trujillo" - Annual Survey, Drydocking, CS Machinery.
- "Zulia" - Boiler Survey.
- "Pablo Moran" - Annual Drydocking.
- "Abobo" - CS Machinery.
- "Creole" - CS Machinery, Donkey Boilers.

Ships under repairs are now:

"Zulia" - m.v. "Trujillo" and m.v. "Aragua".

The m.v. "Zulia" will be drydocked after the m.v. "Trujillo", now in drydock with fractured bottom plates, repairs of which will take about 10 days.

The motor tug "Pablo Moran" ex "Miranda", is now under repair at Maracaibo, CS Machinery and Annual Drydocking.

At this moment seven ships are awaiting their turn in the way in Venezuela, which can do the various jobs properly.

Dear Sir, I shall do my utmost to send you all the reports as I can, which of course, depends on the days I can stay in Caracas.
