MOS - This vessel is now under repairs at Curacao.

CO - Will be drydocked after drydocking of "APURE"
which vessel is now under repairs at Port of Spain.

ORINOCO - Portside donkey boiler examined May, 1957.
Starboard donkey boiler August 1957.
Safety valves of both boilers adjusted on
the 20th September 1957.

Finally I beg to advise you, that the tugs lately sold
all to Moran, have been handed back to Shell again.
