With reference to your letter of 13th November, last, ours of the 19th November, 1959, and also letter from J.O.N. Douglas, the Society's Surveyor in Cadiz, I enclose copy of Report 8 and 9, and details of Ultrasonic guaging on the steel work. Mr. L.G. Seitsinger and his assistant, of Messrs. Engineering test services of 23, Wormwood Street, London, E.C.3. also drill tests which were carried out by H.M. Dockyard and witnessed by Mr. Douglas and myself.

As will be noted the survey was mainly confined to the condition of the hull, and only the essential fittings, such as the sea valves and underwater fittings were submitted by the owners for examination.

The fee proposed in this case is:-

Hull £50 - Expenses £10

Machinery £20 - Expenses £5

and I trust that this will be in order.

I understand that this fee will be collected from Messrs. Shell Tankers Ltd., Ibex House, London, and credited to my account with the Society in due course.

During the joint survey at Gibraltar, £20 was advanced to Mr. Douglas. This can be adjusted in our forthcoming quarterly account.
