Dear Sir,

This ship, which is reported to have been severely damaged by fire, arrived at this Port in tow on the 1st of this month.

We were then informed by the local Agent that whilst representatives of various parties including Underwriters, Salvage Association, etc. had been invited to attend the next day, he had not received instructions from the Owners to call in Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

It was understood that the reason for this delay in calling us in was that Owners' idea was that the ship would prove a "constructive total loss".

Today, upon enquiry, I learned from the local Agent that the Owners have issued a notification of abandonment to consignees and to time charterers and that representatives of Owners and underwriters are still considering the possibilities of a "constructive total loss".

We shall keep you advised of developments.
