With reference to your letters of the 12th June and 17th July concerning the General Examination on the subject vessel.

The General Examination of the hull has been carried out with the exception of the inspection of the holds and tween decks and will be reported in due course.

The vessel was carrying a full cargo and examination of the holds and tween decks was not possible. However, the Master of the vessel produced a list dated 3rd May, 1963, Rotterdam, which read as follows:

Examined: No. 1 hold
No. 2 hold (aft part partly loaded)
No. 4 hold

As a great part of cargo battens are missing, these holds will not be accepted for Special Survey. Upon completion of cargo battens and surveyed by Surveyors, the above holds will be accepted for Special Survey.

The signature on the above list appeared to be 'G. KAMP'.

The Owners state that the vessel is expected to arrive in Hamburg on the 20th September for completion of Special Survey.

As regards the Machinery, a complete General Examination has been held.
