Motorship "GLOUCESTER".

I have your letter of the 12th instant, and in reply would inform you that the Committee will be prepared to maintain this ship in class until 31st October next, provided she is generally inspected at the survey that will be necessary for the extension of the Loadline Certificate before 28th June 1966. The extent of that survey will be left to the Surveyors' discretion, but they will be expected especially to bear in mind the outstanding qualifications of class.

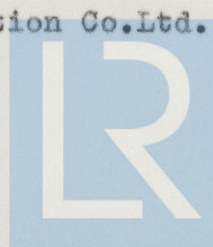
So far as the refrigerating machinery class is concerned, a loading port survey should be held if the running survey is not completed by September next, and the ship is to carry a refrigerated cargo.
