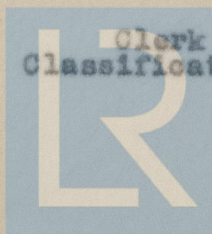
Dear Sir,

3. With reference to your letters of the 9th June and 29th July regarding the basis of First Entry Fees for the steamer "MANCHESTER TRADER" and motorship "GLOUCESTER", I have to acquaint you that the Chairmen have concurred in the submission put forward by Doctor Montgomerie to the effect that for those vessels which are now being dealt with under the Government scheme of permitting an increased immersion of 12" the First Entry Fees will have to be based upon the gross tonnage appearing on the ship's register, namely that measured to the second deck, having regard to the fact that this tonnage will be entered in the Register Book and thus qualifies for the basis of fee assignment provided for in the Rules.
