Dear Sirs,

With reference to Greenock First Entry report No.22537 on the steamer "CLAN URQUHART", it is noted that the two W.T. boilers have been constructed for a working pressure of 240 lb per sq. inch with a corresponding pressure at the superheaters of 230 lb, while the cylindrical boiler has been approved for 220 lb. It is concluded, therefore, that the safety valves on the steam drum of the W.T. boilers have been adjusted to 230 lb and those on the superheaters to 220 lb, but I shall be obliged if you will kindly confirm this.


