Comércio e Navegação at this port on the 22nd May, 1964 and subsequently on account of temporary repairs to bottom damage stated to have been sustained due to grounding at Salvador on the 17th April, 1964 in the loaded condition

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all temporary repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am

recommending that she be retained as now Classed without fresh record of drydocking subject to the ship proceeding direct to a repair port on completion of present voyage to effect permanent repairs in drydock to include and set up stem, keel and bottom plating and internals in way, (p. & a), in way of fore peak, No 1 and No 2 double bottom tanks, also to all other conditions at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously recommended.
