

Steamer "SALAMMANNA"

(Av 7206)

Mr. John Vlassopoulos<sup>4</sup> telephoned this morning and stated that this ship is loaded at Kingston and the Owners have heard from the Master that the Surveyor has refused to issue a certificate to allow the ship to proceed.

It appears that she left Rio with a full cargo for Trinidad and during the voyage a settlement was reached with the Underwriters on the understanding that the ship would be scrapped. She has therefore been sold to Spain for scrap, and to get her to this side the Owners took her from Trinidad to Haiti where she loaded a cargo of concentrates. No Surveyor was available there and the ship therefore proceeded to Kingston where they asked for a certificate to cover the voyage to the Continent in the loaded condition.

The case has been discussed with Mr. Todd who considers that the only course available is to ask the Rio Surveyors for their comments and this suggestion has been put to Mr. Vlassopoulos who agrees and asks that a full rate cablegram be sent.
