We are in receipt of your classing letter of the 18th January, 1946 relating to the test pressures on steam pipes of the s.s. "Shakespeare Park", recently completed in this district.

Mr. McGhee, the Engineer Surveyor looking after the boilers and machinery whilst being installed, is no longer with the Society, but from his journal it has been verified that these particular pipes had been tested on 5th October, 1945 to 600 lbs. pressure per sq. inch after being bent.

For your information, we enclose copy of a certificate, received from our Toronto office, covering the inspection and testing of these pipes at place of manufacture, all of which it is hoped is in order.
