This is to Certify that at the request of Messrs. Holme Ringer & Co., Ltd., Lloyd's Agents Moji, Japan, on behalf of the Salvage Association, London and with the consent of the Owner's Representative the undersigned Surveyors attended on board

S.S. "CLOVELLY" 3,655 gross tons of Panama

whilst the ship was lying in drydock at the Works of Messrs. Sasebo Heavy Industries Co., Ltd., Sasebo, Japan on the 9th January 1967 and on subsequent dates to ascertain the nature and extent of damage stated sustained as follows.

Heavy weather experienced during part-loaded voyage from Osaka Japan to Indonesia via Hong Kong between 1 - 8 January 1967.

For further particulars see vessel's log books.

In our opinion this damage stated may be reasonably attributable to the causes stated.

Upon examination the following damage was found and repairs recommended without prejudice to the terms and conditions of insurance.

The ship was placed in drydock on the 9th January 1967.

The ship was previously in drydock at Hong Kong March 1966.

Found

Rudder stock sheared off and rudder missing.
Sternframe backpost and skeg missing.
Propeller tips damaged.

Recommended

Rudder stock and rudder to renew.
Sternframe backpost and skeg to renew.
Propeller to repair.

Note:-

The vessel proceeded from drydock to the Anchorage at Sasebo to await a decision by the Owners on whether repairs would be carried out. On 28th June we were informed by the Owner's Agents that the vessel had been sold to Mitsubishi Shoji K.K. and was towed to Shodo Island for breaking up.
