The scantlings are suitable for a draught which is 11 1/2" less than that corresponding to the freeboard which could be assigned as a F.S. vessel.

The tank top plating has been increased in thickness in lieu of ceiling under the hatchways.

Heavy derricks have been fitted.

The vessel has been arranged for the carriage of case oil.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be

classified as "LOCAL" "With freeboard" "Fitted for oil fuel 5.45, FP above 150°F" 5.45 Hpl.

The Summer Freeboard as shown on the attached extract from the Freeboard Verification Form, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted in the classification certificate and recorded in the Register Book, and further, the remaining freeboards, as shown on the accompanying extract, to be inserted in the certificate of classification.



It is submitted the Surveyor be requested to state the widths of the upper deck sheerstrake and strakes below, which have been omitted from their report.


