Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your freeboard report No. 1495 on Messrs. Chantier de Penhoet, St. Nazaire, and No. U5, and with regard thereto I enclose the usual printed letter setting forth the freeboards which have been provisionally assigned, subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on completion of the vessel, to the usual covers being fitted to the openings in the steel tween deck bulkheads in way of the tonnage opening, and to efficient temporary covers being provided for closing the tonnage opening on the superstructure deck.

The freeboards have been computed on a corrected tonnage coefficient of .74 and are subject to alteration if found necessary.

When forwarding your final freeboard report I shall be glad if you will give particulars of the freeing ports situated in the tonnage well, and state whether non-return valves are fitted to the overboard scuppers from the tween decks.
