
This ship stranded and sank near Cape Machichaco, Spain, in fog.

In reply to my casualty letter of 1st March, 1961, the owner stated that she was not yet a total loss and that negotiations were in progress with a view to refloating. In reply to further enquiries throughout the year, our surveyor at Gijon informed me that salvage operations were in progress and refloating was imminent.

However, on 3rd February, 1962, he states that the ship is still submerged and salvage operations have been suspended until the Spring.
