I acknowledge your letter of the 14th instant, and in reply am pleased to inform you that the Committee are agreeable to the drydocking being postponed until August next as now proposed.

With regard to the final paragraph of your letter, it is thought well to inform you that the Committee are not prepared to give an automatic extension of up to 24 months for a Drydocking Survey, and although the Rule quoted by you is broadly the basis on which the Committee make their decisions, they always reserve the right to require drydocking at a lesser period, particularly in a case like the present one, in view of her age.
