S.S. "SILVER VALLEY"

A Report of the Survey carried out at Trieste during January has received the consideration of the Committee, as a result of which a record of Main Boiler Survey 1,63 has been assigned.

The class has now been continued subject to indented side shell plating etc, abreast No.1 hatch (portside) with internal structure in way being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey.

I would point out that the ship has not been seen in Drydock by the Society's Surveyors since September 1961, and the Survey of the Liberty type Screwshaft will become due at the end of May next, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements it is proposed to make to carry out these inspections.

It has been learnt that the ship was placed in Drydock at Trieste during January and, although the Surveyors offered their services, the ship was undocked without any request being made for a Survey to be carried out.
