Additional accommodation now provided for gunners in No. 5 tween deck (s.s.)

Temporary wood bulkheads fitted.

2 Additional side scuttles 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ " dia. with hinged deadlights.

2 Additional ventilators on freeboard deck (s.s.) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. x 36" x 5 $\frac{1}{16}$ "

Wood plugs and covers provided.

The after bulkhead in the tween deck has been cut for access to this
accommodation, size of opening 5'6" x 24", sill 15". Framed wood door fitted.

The bulkhead in way of this opening has been drilled W.T. pitch and a steel
plate and bolts supplied to provide a closing appliance for use when the
accommodation is dispensed with.
