The D.E.M.S. quarters at after end of bridge space (p.s.) have been dispensed with at this time.

Companionway, sidescattles, sanitary discharge, ventilators<sup>at</sup> removed and openings closed in an efficient manner.

It is noted that bridge end and poopfront access openings originally closed by stormboards in riveted channels are now closed by portable steel plates secured by hook bolts.

The openings in the bridge tween deck bulkheads (closed by riveted plates as a Wartime emergency measure) have now been restored and are fitted with stormboards in riveted channels.
