I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 30th ultimo and have to inform you that the case of the "CABADELO" has been submitted to the Committee at their Meeting today. In the circumstances they are agreeable to this vessel retaining the record "Lloyd's RMC 7.45" in the Register Book for the present, subject to a further survey of the Refrigerating Installation being carried out before refrigerated cargo is again loaded. I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.

A similar arrangement has already been agreed to in the cases of the Steamers "BARBACENA" and "ALEGRETE", as intimated in my letters of the 17th October last, while in the case of the "ATALAIA" the record of "Lloyd's RMC 10.46" has recently been assigned.
