

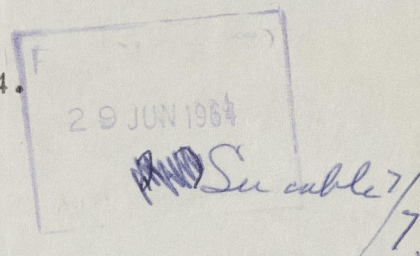


This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 19th inst. with reference to our damage report dated 11th May, 1964, No. C-1612.

It is not understood about a letter of instructions, but the request to carry out a damage survey was made by Messrs. Furness Withy & Co. Ltd., St. John's, in which our report was forwarded to them. It is now good practise to carry out surveys on vessels where separate interests are involved.

An independent surveyor carried out a survey on behalf of the master through the ship's agents, Messrs. A. Harvey & Co. Ltd., because of the fact that the undersigned was engaged for the other parties.

It is not clear as to what information you may require in connection with this case, and if we can be of assistance, please advise.
