This ship has sustained extensive damage to the port main engine crankshaft. As a result of an examination at this Port the damage was found to be of such a magnitude that the Owners have decided that no repairs shall be carried out to the port main engine and that the ship will proceed on the starboard engine to the breaker's yard at Hong Kong or Japan.

After satisfactory trials of the starboard main engine it is proposed to issue a Cert. B 1 for the voyage direct to the breaker's yard only.
