Port No.2 and starboard Nos.1 and 4 cylinders,  
pistons and rods valves and gears.  
Port No.3 and starboard Nos.1 and 2 side, port ~~and~~  
No.2<sup>2</sup> starboard Nos.1, 3 and 4 centre connecting  
rods top ends and guides.  
Port Nos.2 and 4 and starboard No.2 side, port Nos.1,  
2 and 4 and starboard Nos.1 and 2 centre crankpins  
and bearings.  
Port and starboard scavenge pumps.  
Bilge pump.  
No.2 fuel transfer pump.  
Freshwater coolers.
