With reference to your letter of the 2nd September, I would inform you that the Boiler Survey was commenced at Bremen on the 25th September, but no action was taken regarding the Steampipe Survey. In the circumstances I shall be glad to learn what further arrangements are proposed to be made for this inspection to be carried out.

To complete the Boiler Survey, for the record MBS 9.64, the starboard boiler remains to be examined, the safety valves of both boilers adjusted and the oil burning system and remote controls examined and your intentions regarding these matters will be appreciated in due course.

I take this opportunity to remind you that the vessel has not been seen in drydock by the Society's Surveyors since August 1963.
