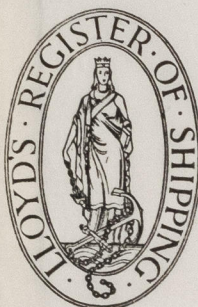

This is to Certify that

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners and written authority of the Lebanese Consul, arrange for a survey on board the steamship "HALCYON MED", 1948 tons gross of Beyrouth, on the 15th March, 1960, and subsequently, as she lay in the Edinburgh Dock, Leith, for the purpose of examining the Radiotelegraphy Equipment in the manner prescribed in the Regulations annexed to the International Convention for Safety of Life at Sea, 1948.

A report of the survey will be sent to the Society's London Office, with the recommendation that a Certificate of Safety Radiotelegraphy Survey be issued.
