One Auxiliary set for National Benzole Cos. 125 ton tanker consisting of 1L2 Diesel engine developing $9\frac{1}{2}$ B.H.P. at 1000 r.p.m. fitted with rotary type circulating pump, flywheel and governor, driving one Gardner two stage air compressor with a capacity of about 15 cub.ft. up to 360 lbs. in 30 minutes.

One Sunderland Forge 5 k.w. 110 volt flame and explosion proof generator complete with shunt regulator.

One General service pump having a capacity of 3300 gallons per hour at 50 ft. head, the water end of pump being entirely in gunmetal.

The whole of the foregoing units to be mounted on a C.I. bedplate. Standard outfit of spare gear and tools and three sets of working instructions. One set of cloth tracings and 6 black and white prints off each of arrangement and detail drawings. The whole to comply with P.L.A. and B.O.T. regulations and to be built under British Corporation survey and their certificate supplied. To be guaranteed against any defect for a period of 6 months after vessel is handed over.
