We are in receipt of your letter dated 29th June 1966 and have to confirm that the "ALVA CAPE" sank at approximately latitude 39 degrees North, longitude 72 degrees 20 minutes West at 10.6 p.m. on 3rd July 1966.

In answer to the third paragraph of your letter we have to inform you that at the time of the collision with the "Texaco Massachusetts" on the 16th June 1966 the "Alva Cape" had a cargo of approximately 143,000 barrels of Naphtha, and was on a voyage from Karachi to New York.
