With reference to your letter of the 26th January, I shall be glad to learn if you are yet in a position to let me know when, and at which port the Screwshaft Survey is to be held, in order that the Society's Surveyors concerned may be advised.

I take this opportunity to remind you that the machinery class of this vessel is at present subject as below, and your intentions regarding the items which expire at the end of this month will be appreciated:-

- (1) Main Engine No. 2 cylinder liner (metalocked 11.64) being specially examined by the end of this month.
- (2) Main Engine forward S.W. cooling pump discharge valve (cracked) being renewed at the earliest opportunity and by the end of this month.
- (3) Main Engine No. 1 cylinder liner (metalocked 1.65) being specially examined by the end of July 1965.
- (4) Auxiliary condenser overboard discharge valve chest being renewed by the end of this month.
