I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant respecting the motorship "NASSA", and think it well to remark that, according to the circulars regarding Bessemer steel pipes made from Corby steel, no distinction is made between main and auxiliary steam piping. It is considered therefore that a note should have been made on the First Entry Report that some of the auxiliary steam pipes are of Bessemer steel, as such pipes will require examination after four years' service, and I shall be obliged if you will inform the Surveyors accordingly.
